

Backing up photos & videos from an iPhone

(On a Mac)

1. Connect your iPhone to your Mac's USB port with the cable that came with it—or the one you use to charge it with.
2. *iTunes* may launch automatically and ask you if you wish to *allow this computer to access the information on your iPhone*—click *continue*.
3. Your iPhone may ask you if you *Trust This Computer?*—tap on *Trust*.
4. Quit *iTunes*.
5. Launch *Image Capture* from the *Others* folder on your *Launchpad*.
6. You should see your iPhone on the left sidebar—and all the photos & videos in it on the right.
7. Select the files you wish...
 - a. to import only a few select files, click on them by holding down the *Command (⌘) key*; or
 - b. to select it all, use the shortcut *Command (⌘) key + A key*.
8. From the *Import to* drop-down menu at the bottom of the window, select the destination folder.
9. Click on *Import*.
10. Your files will now begin to copy over.
11. Once it's done, quit *Image Capture*.
12. All your selected photos & videos will now be in the folder you chose to import to.
