

Backing up photos & videos form an iPhone

(On a PC)

1. Connect your iPhone to your PC's USB port with the cable that came with it—or the one you use to charge it with.
2. *iTunes* may launch automatically and ask you if you wish to *allow this computer to access the information on your iPhone*—click *continue*.
3. Your iPhone may ask you if you *Trust This Computer?*—tap on *Trust*.
4. Close *iTunes*.
5. Launch the *File Explorer* and click on *This PC* in the sidebar.
6. On the right—under *Devices and drives*—you should see your iPhone. Enter it to access its internal storage.
7. There will be a folder called *DCIM* in it. Within this will be a folder that contains all your photos and videos.
8. Select the files you wish...
 - a. to import only a few select files, click on them by holding down the *Control (^) key*; or
 - b. to select it all, use the shortcut *Control (^) key + A key*.
9. Right click on your selection and select *Copy* from the pop-up menu.
10. Navigate to a folder on your PC where you wish to backup these files.
11. Right click in a blank area within that folder and select *Paste* from the pop-up menu.
12. All your selected photos & videos will now be backed up into that folder.
